 ASEAN's external partners.








































- To create place for people






Smart City Project 2: Transit Oriented Development (TOD) in Hlaing Thar Yar Township

TOD intends to achieve preferable urban functions like high economic efficiency, living convenience, and environmental friendliness by conjugating urban development with public transportation.










Linkage between Users and Yangon Map Platform










Definitions of Yangon Building Regulations on YCDC website


